

Plant Food




A As you know, plants make their own food. Let us read how they do this.


1. During the day, the leaves soak in lots of sunlight.



2. The roots drink up water and the (or stem) carries it up to the leaves.



3. The leaves also take in carbon dioxide.




4. Just like we use ingredients to cook our food, plants use these three ingredients to make a sugary food called glucose. The process is called photosynthesis.

5. Just like food gives us energy, glucose gives energy to the plant.



6. As plants make their food, oxygen is given out. And this is used by us!


