



Assertive to imperative:-

- ① In order to change an assertive sentence into an imperative sentence we need to omit the sub & and helping verb

Example:- ① You should do the work.

→ Do the work.

② You speak the truth.

→ Speak the truth

- ② If the assertive sentence is negative in sense then while converting it into imperative follow the structure —

Do not/Don't + Base form of the main verb + remaining

Example:- You should not waste your time.



⇒ Don't waste your time.

② You do not go out.

⇒ Do not go out.

③ While converting an assertive sentence that contains the word never follow the structure.

Never + Base form of the main verb + remain_{-ing}

Example:- You should never tell lie.

⇒ Never tell a lie.

④ If the subject of the assertive sentence is first person or third person then while converting it into imperative use

Let + objective form of the given sub + verb + remaining

Example:- ① He plays cricket
→ Let him play cricket.

⑤ If the subject of the assertive sentence is first or third person and the sentence is in negative form then while converting it into imperative follow the rule.

Let + objective form of the subject
+ not + verb + remaining

Example:- ① We do not hate the poor.

→ Let us not hate the poor.

* If the verb or object of the let verb is noun then place not before the noun and if

the object of the let verb is pronoun
then place not after the pronoun.

example ① Rahim does not tell a lie

⇒ Let not Rahim tell a lie.

Interrogative to assertive

① There are two steps -

Step-1 Move → Helping verb to the second position in the sentence - ce

Step-2 → If the sentence is positive then convert it into negative and if it is negative then convert it into positive.

Example: - Isn't this the place I love the most?

Step-1 This isn't the place I love the most.

Step-2 This is the place I love the most.

Case-1 Ever → Never
Any → No

Will you ever forgive her?

step → You will ever forgive her

step → You will never forgive her.

Case-2 who + (Don't/Doesn't/Didn't)

↓
Everybody / Everyone / All

Example: who doesn't want to be rich?

→ Everybody wants to be rich.

Case-3 who + Positive sentence

↓
No-one / Nobody

Example: who was playing the match?

⇒ No one was playing the match

Case 4 — why + verb



It is foolish to + verb + rest of the sentence

Example: - why waste time in useless work?

⇒ It is foolish to waste time in useless work.

Case 5 → what if → It doesn't matter

Example: - what if you do not help me

⇒ It doesn't matter if you do not help me.
